

Road safety in Sourton

Sourton Village and the neighbouring hamlets Lake and Southerly are bisected by the A386. Along the 3128m from the 40mph at the start of Sourton Village to the parish boundary at Southerly there are 9 footpaths and bridleways crossing the main road. Dartmoor is also East side of the village which has a large number of visitors each year. Sourton is also a farming area so animals and farm vehicle are often in the area neither of which move at a high speed.
